I get angry a lot, and that is a sin, and I don't want it anymore."

We went through the counseling session, and then he prayed and asked Jesus to come into his heart and take his sin away. He then added, "Jesus, please help me not to get angry again. Amen." I prayed with Him and told him that Miss Sarah and I are excited that he asks Jesus in his heart. I also told him that the angels are excited for him.
